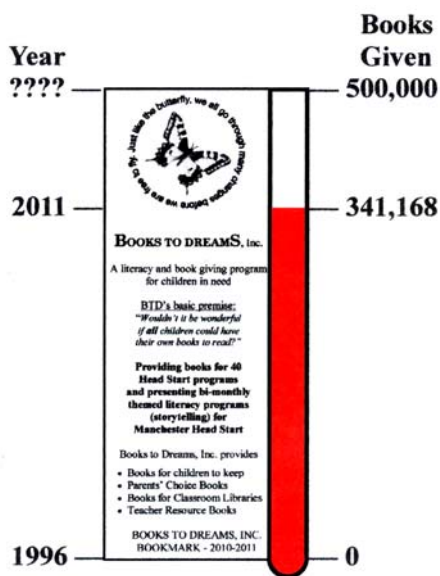

Books to Dreams has gone in a new direction since **January 1, 2009**. We **specialize** in **HEAD START PROGRAMS** where we provide books and literacy programs.

**B. BTM PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAMS - HEAD START (MANCHESTER)**

A total of **18** storytelling programs (2 programs per classroom) per year were presented. **162** children were provided with books to keep, along with the themed programs. (These **324** books are in addition to the numbers in the Head Start Table above.)
